APPLICATIONS - ADMISSION PROCEDURE - DEADLINES

The basic conditions for admission to the Faculty are:

- a) Successful completion of a Bachelor´s degree
- b) Submission of an application by 31 March 2026
- c) Submission of the required documents by 31 March / 1 July 2026.
- d) Successful completion of the entrance exam

 - Pay admission fee **CZK 950** (appx. EUR 38) by **31 March 2026**.
 - Only after payment of the fee will the application be included in the admission process. A section for uploading attachments will appear in the application only after payment of the fee.

Submit required documents by 31 March/ 1 July 2026:

- Copy of **Bachelor diploma** and **Transcript of bachelor courses**
- **Language certificate** (certificate of minimum English level B2 or confirmation of English as a Medium of instruction (MOI)).
- [Authenticated copy of a certificate of recognition or validation of the Bachelor degree diploma](#) (also referred to as Nostrification). The Nostrification means that your study up to now is at the same level as the Bachelor degree study in the Czech Republic. The Nostrification is provided by [CTU Rector's Office](#).
- Branch-related representative works : See [Dean's Directive](#), article 7, part 2J (ONLY applicants for program Buildings and Environment)

No Certificate of Health is required

ENTRANCE EXAM

- All applicants must take the entrance exam.
 - Applicants cannot be exempted from the entrance exam; previous experience is not taken into account.
 - The entrance examination consists of a written test in branch-oriented thematic areas.
 - Example of an entrance test: See [Dean's Directive](#), Appendix 1.
 - The entrance exam will take place in the Faculty of Civil Engineering: **20. – 22. May 2026**. In addition to this date, it is also possible to take the exam earlier upon request (at the end of March) in order to receive the acceptance letter and visa processing earlier.
 - Applicants can apply to take the entrance exam online. [Requests](#) for an online exam, including an explanation, must be sent to study@cvut.cz as soon as possible, no later than 10 May 2026.

ENROLLMENT IN STUDIES

Enrollment must be completed in person at the Faculty of Civil Engineering.

Step 1: Register for enrollment via [the electronic application](#) between June 1 and September 16, 2026. This is only possible after receiving the official Decision on Admission.

Step 2: Attend the official enrollment at the Study Department on one of the following dates: July 2, September 9, or September 16, 2026.

The study contract will be signed on the day of enrollment.

FEE STRUCTURE:

- **Application fee: CZK 950**
 - **Nostrification fee: CZK 950** (valid for one admission process at CTU) or **CZK 3 000** (with nationwide and unlimited validity in the Czech Republic)
 - **Tuition Fee: CZK 500 per semester** (CZK 1 100 per one academic year).
NOT cover any payments of accommodation, food, transportation, medical insurance, books or any other personal expenses.
Detailed payment instructions will be provided on the day of enrollment.
The tuition fee for the first semester of study is due by September 21, 2026.

The **process** of obtaining a visa for study purposes can take up to **60–90 days**; therefore, applying well in advance is recommended.

- 1) The **Decision on Admission** (Letter of Acceptance) is required for the visa application; however, it can only be issued after all required documents have been submitted to the **faculty** and the entrance examination has been successfully passed.
 - Early submission of all documents in the application portal is highly recommended, as the nostrification process may take up to 30 days.
- 2) A **confirmation of accommodation** from the dormitory and **valid international health insurance** are required for the visa process.
